

The Palladio Foundation appoints Joachim Pflieger as General Delegate.

As announced at the time of the recent appointment of its vice-presidents, the Palladio Foundation announces that Joachim Pflieger is joining the Foundation as General Delegate. This appointment completes the overhaul of governance announced at the end of 2023 and begun since then.

Joachim Pflieger, 39, holds a master's degree in European Affairs from Sciences Po Paris, earned in 2006, and an Executive Master in Executive Leadership from Sciences Po Paris, completed in 2022. He was a laureate of the incubation program at Philanthro-Lab in Paris for the 2022-2023 period.

He began his career at the Paris national Opera and the Teatro Real Foundation in Madrid, holding then various positions including Executive Director at Galerie Thaddaeus Ropac (Paris and Pantin), General Director of the Fimenco Foundation, and Director of the Ambition Saint-Denis Endowment Fund since 2022. He serves on the boards of directors of "Suivez la Flèche" association in Saint-Denis and "Villes et Musiques du Monde" association in Aubervilliers. Additionally, he teaches strategies and management of diversity and inclusion at Sciences Po Paris in Public affairs and International affairs.

He will take up his role as General Delegate by the end of June 2024.
